The Boothbay Region sailing team represents schools in our area (currently Lincoln Academy, BRHS and BRES) in fleet and team race regattas against other schools throughout New England, predominantly in Maine. The team competes in the New England Scholastic Sailing Association (NESSA) within the Interscholastic Sailing Association (ISSA), which governs all High School Sailing in the country. We also compete locally within the Pen Bay League, which currently includes our team, Camden Hills, Blue Hill, MDI, Isleboro and Rockland. Although only HS sailors are eligible for NESSA events, Middle school sailors are welcome in practice and at Pen Bay Events, as well as a few others.

## Who Is Eligible for the Team

Middle and high school sailors of all levels are welcome to join the team and no experience is needed. We accept sailors from area schools who do not have a program. Please remember that middle school sailors will not be eligible to sail in all events. As with all school sports, your school's academic eligibility rules will apply. For those with little to no experience, we will have some practice days as learn to sail, depending on interest. Otherwise we will teach you as we go.

Sailing is the only recognized coed sport in high school. Our team is open to both boys and girls.
